We are making headway with \$14,000 raised toward our \$25,000 in start-up costs. One couple made a \$1,000 donation that is very much appreciated and David and Sylvia Dennison are donating a suite of office furniture and supplies for our village office. We are also pleased to announce that Neighbors Inc. has pledged to donate \$500 to East Rock Creek Village, and the Shepherd Park Citizens Association has asked us to make a presentation at their September 16, 2015 meeting in support of our donation request. Supporters are welcome to come.

Our village opening costs include: hiring an executive director, renting office space, setting up that office, conducting volunteer training, paying for background checks on volunteers, printing up membership and volunteer manuals, and purchasing liability insurance.

On September 1, 2015, we submitted a grant proposal to Advisory Neighborhood Commission (ANC) 4A for a \$3,000 community grant to support the

background screening and training of our volunteers. ERCV board members will make a presentation in support of our application at the October 6, 2015 meeting of ANC 4A at Ft. Stevens Recreation Center. Please feel free to attend in support.

ERCV will submit a community grant proposal to pay for computer equipment and technology to ANC 4B in early September for a vote at their October 26, 2015 meeting.

Ohev Sholom's Seniors Committee is planning to host a fundraiser for ERCV in early October 2015, so please look for mention of that in our upcoming newsletter.
